



I am going to the Adelaide Zoo.

Inside the zoo, I need to walk with an adult.





I can wear a wrist band with my carers phone number on it. If I get lost an adult can call the number to find my carer.

There are toilets at the zoo. There might be other people in the toilets.



There is a map and signs to help us find the animals.





The animals are all kept inside special enclosures. They are safe and cared for by the zoo keepers. The animals cannot get out of their enclosures. I don't touch the animals unless a zoo keeper tells me I can.




There are some bird aviaries - which are areas with walls and a roof where birds can fly around. I can walk inside there if I want. The birds might fly near me, and they won't hurt me.

There is a playground at the zoo. If I want to, I can have a play there.






There will be crafts and activities for me to do on the grass area and under the rotunda.
