USING ANY ROUND CONTAINER, CUT SOME GREEN CARDBOARD AND WRAP AND TAPE AROUND THE SIDE OF THE CONTAINER.

CUT A CIRCLE SLIGHTLY BIGGER THE SIZE OF THE CONTAINER TO FORM THE MOUTH.

FOLD THE CIRCLE IN HALF AND GLUE HALF OF THE CIRCLE TO THE TOP OF THE CONTAINER TO CREATE THE MOUTH.



CUT AND GLUE SMALL CIRCLES FOR THE EYES. (YOU CAN DRAW THE EYES ON OR USE GOOGLEY EYES OR EYE STICKERS.)

USING TWEEZERS, SEE WHO CAN FEED THE FROG. YOU COULD USE ANYTHING TO FEED THE FROG - LEGO, FAKE BUGS, OR ANYTHING LYING AROUND THE HOUSE.

THIS IS A GREAT ACTIVITY FOR FINE MOTOR SKILLS AND IT CAN BE USED TO INCORPORATE COUNTING, IE. 'HOW MANY THINGS WERE FED TO THE FROG?'



An adorable book with simple, engaging text and beautiful illustrations. If you've ever tried to get a toddler ready in the morning, you'll relate to this story.






10 Spooky Bats by Ed Allen & Shane McG



Parachute Play is very popular and super fun for Playgroupers of all ages. It assists in the development of upper body strength and coordination. As it is a group activity, it also helps children to learn social skills.

If your Playgroup doesn't have a parachute, you may be able to borrow one from your local Toy Library, or you can use a bed sheet for many parachute games.

Parachute Games

that your Playgroup may like to try include:

Popcorn

- Children and parents/carers stand around the outside parachute holding the edge
- Place popcorn (three balls of paper) on top of the parachute
- Everyone moves parachute up and down making the 'popcorn' pop.
- Try going for as long as you can without letting 'popcorn' fall off of the parachute and onto the ground.

Mushroom House

- Children and parents/carers stand or kneel around the outside of the parachute holding the edge.
- Everyone raises and lowers the parachute slowly twice.
- Raise the parachute again, with everyone taking one step in and pulling parachute down behind them.
- Sit on the edge of the parachute, making a mushroom with everyone inside.
- Stay inside until mushroom starts to collapse or you all get too hot whichever comes first.

Extension Ideas

Use the parachute for musical games such as Ring a Ring a Rosie (walking around the parachute) and Row Row Row Your Boat (holding parachute while rocking to and fro).

Play colour games using the parachute by pointing to a colour on the parachute and encouraging children wearing that colour to do a specific action, e.g.. crawling under or skipping over parachute.

Modify activities or make up new games to suit the needs and interests of your playgroup.

Quiet Parachute Games

A parachute can be used for quiet games – great for settling young children at the end of a busy Playgroup session. You may like to try the active games first and then finish with some quieter activities such as these:

Cool Waves

- Children (including babies) lie, sit or crouch under the parachute.
- Play a recording of relaxing music while waving the parachute up and down in gentle waves over the children.

Roll the Parachute

This is a great activity with which to finish parachute play.

Children and parents/carers slowly roll the parachute as they walk into the centre of the circle.

An adult takes the parachute and puts it away.

Extension Ideas

Attach scarves to the bottom of the parachute for activities where children are underneath it (e.g.. Cool Waves game) for additional colour and interest.

Start off with music with a faster tempo, then change to slow, relaxing music.

Combine quiet songs, e.g.. lullabies with parachute play.
