

Paper Plate Snake

Children will need:

Paper plate

Pop stick

Scissors

Sticky Tape

Paints/textas/pencils/crayons

Draw a spiral shape on a paper plate and then cut along the spiral line.

Draw on some eyes and a tongue.

Some ideas for decorating are:

Colour in or paint your snake lots of colours to make a rainbow snake.

Use your finger to paint dots on your snake.

Use textas/pencils/crayons and draw lots of lines to make a striped snake.

Tape a pop-stick to the back of your snake's head.

You can now move your snake up and down.
