



### **PlayConnect**

PlayConnect Playgroups are here to benefit the whole family and carers of children 0-6 years who may have Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) characteristics, developmental delays in communication and social skills and/or behavioural and sensory issues.

Your child does not require a diagnosis from a medical practitioner. PlayConnect welcomes siblings up to the age of six years and provides a supportive base that allows play and interaction with other families.

It's about connecting with others to talk, play and share information and experiences.



## What will happen at a PlayConnect Playgroup?

PlayConnect Playgroups meet weekly for two hours. Sessions are run by a skilled Development Worker. During playgroup sessions, caregivers and children join in a variety of play experiences, practice skills and have fun.

At a PlayConnect Playgroup you may find:

- > Smaller group sizes
- > Structured routines
- > Visual aids
- > Modelling of play and social activities
- > Positive encouragement
- And a range of activities designed around the interests and needs of each individual family.

Families and carers will also receive information about other services for children within their community.

"when I first started going, I didn't know anyone else with a child with communication and social delays, so meeting other parents was great for me, a relief in a way. In other groups it seemed hard to join in and other parents didn't understand why my child behaves the way they do".

# How will PlayConnect Playgroups benefit our family?

**PlayConnect** can help children build their skills in:

- > Coping with change
- > Following instructions
- > Communication
- > Taking turns

Parents and caregivers say playgroups are beneficial because they are able to connect with other families, share experiences and information and support each other.

## Will my family be able to speak with child health specialists?

PlayConnect is not therapy based however your PlayConnect Development Worker can provide you with information about strategies for play and specialist services for your child in your local area. ### Is there a cost to families?

The Australian Government has funded **PlayConnect** until 2015, this funding will enable families to access **PlayConnect** at minimal cost. Some **PlayConnect** Playgroups may choose to undertake certain activities that are not covered by the funding therefore families may be asked to make a contribution.

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
